



**GlobalMUNers Conference
in New York City
#GMNYC2025**

After 12 annual editions of NYDRMUN, and two successful editions of NYMUNLAC in 2018 and 2019, GlobalMUNers, a private non-profit institution constituted as a civil association in Mexico established an important partnership with National Model United Nations (NMUN), the world's largest and oldest ongoing intercollegiate MUN. This alliance has allowed us to keep alive the sole Model United Nations Conference to be hosted at the UN Headquarters whose primary working language is Spanish.

Over **400 participants**, among them Staff, teachers and students from middle school, high school and college will be traveling from Argentina, Bolivia, Canada, Colombia, Dominican Republic, France, Haiti, Mexico, Panama, Spain, the United States of America, and Venezuela to attend the academic encounter.

GMNYC2025 will take place from Sunday, April 13th to Friday, April 18th, 2025, at the New York Hilton Midtown Convention Center and a conference room at the UN Headquarters in New York City. The conference room that will be assigned within the UN Headquarters of the United Nations will be announced once authorization from the United Nations and its availability is confirmed. In accordance with established practices, meetings of the General Assembly and other intergovernmental bodies take precedence over other meetings and events. In case the General Assembly or any other intergovernmental body needs to meet in the designated conference room, GlobalMUNers will seek an alternate venue.

It is important to remember that in order to make the trip and participate in the academic encounter, all individuals from the invited academic institution must have a valid passport and US Visitor Visa to enter the United States of America.
