## About the Roundtable

On the sidelines of the 80th UN General Assembly, Gavi, the State of Qatar, the Government of Japan and the Gates Foundation will convene an exclusive, high-level panel discussion with ministers, senior policymakers, leaders of multilateral development banks (MDBs), and strategic partners from Africa, the Middle East, and Asia-Pacific.

The dialogue will focus on immunization as the cornerstone of global health; while exploring how Universal Health Coverage (UHC) and innovative financing can serve as enablers to scale and sustain progress. Discussions will highlight how policy reforms, delivery innovations, and new financing partnerships, enhancing sustainable health investment through MDB collaboration, Islamic finance, and blended mechanisms such as Gavi's MDB Multiplier, can accelerate impact and resilience.
