## Enhancing multilateralism and reinforcing nuclear security: EU support to the UN in promoting the universalization and effective implementation of ICSANT

The International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism (ICSANT) is one of the 19 international legal instruments against terrorism, essential for international peace and security. As of June 2023, ICSANT has 120 Parties, meaning that more than one third of the world is not yet protected by the Convention. In order to reach its full potential, and to avoid safe havens, universalization of ICSANT remains a key goal. UNOCT and UNODC have partnered with the EU on joint projects promoting the Convention's universalization and effective implementation. The side event aims to increase awareness on the importance of the universalization and effective implementation of ICSANT as well as to present the results of the EU-UN project (January 2019 - June 2023) and the main priorities of the new upcoming project (July 2023 - June 2026).
