
## Transnational linkages between violence-oriented right-wing extremism/REMVE/terrorism and organized crime: challenges and opportunities for multilateral and institutional cooperation

### Combating the financing of violent extremism and terrorism through exploiting existing vulnerabilities and increased cooperation

Mitigating the risks emanating from the financing of violence oriented-right wing extremism and terrorism, also referred to as violent extremism and terrorism based on xenophobia, racism, and other forms of intolerance, or in the name of religion and belief (XRIRB), presents a challenge for Member States. Increased multilateral cooperation is key to tackling the challenges and disruption opportunities connected to the cooperation between XRIRB and organized crime networks.
