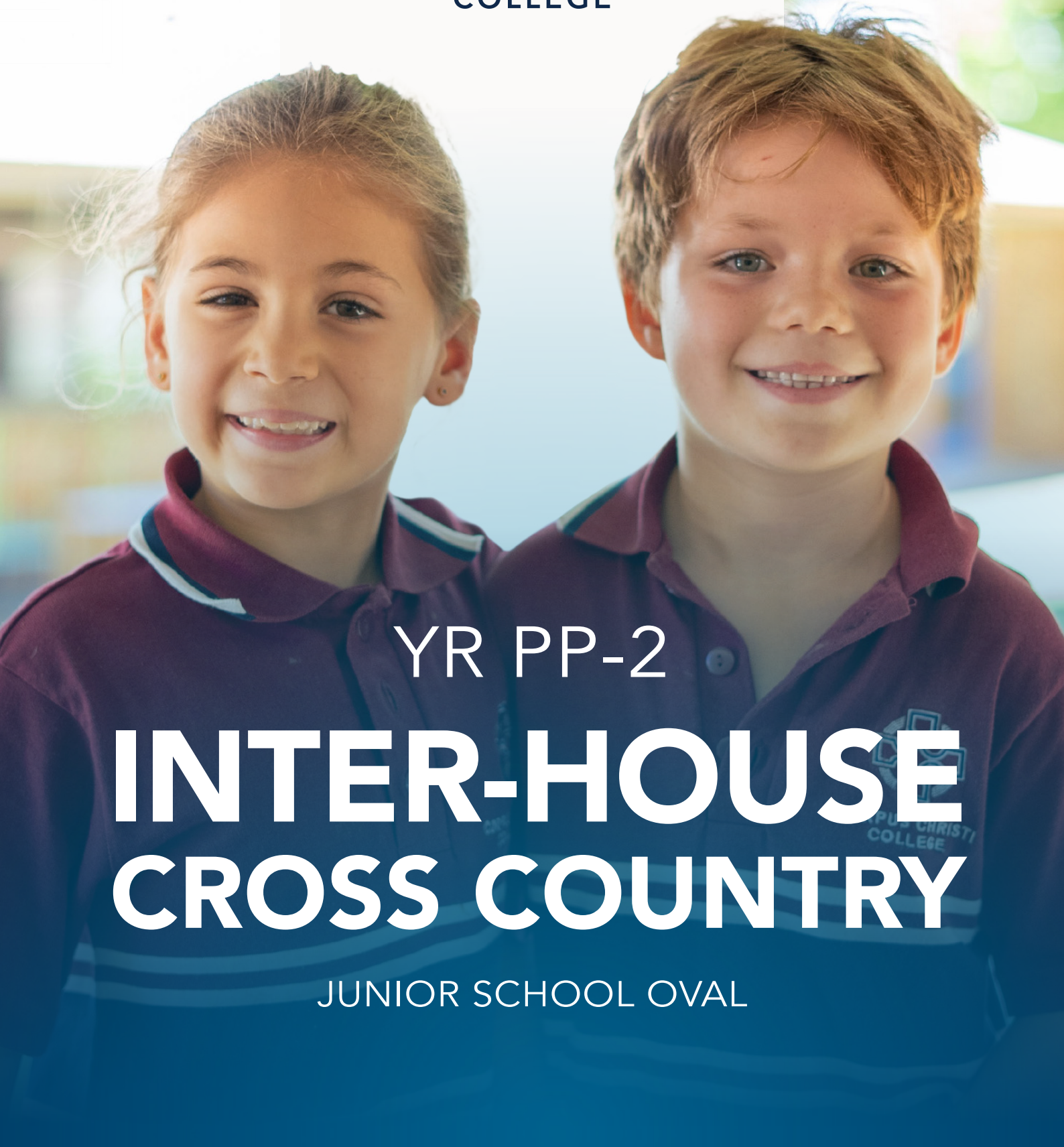

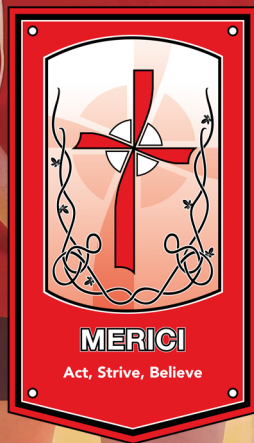

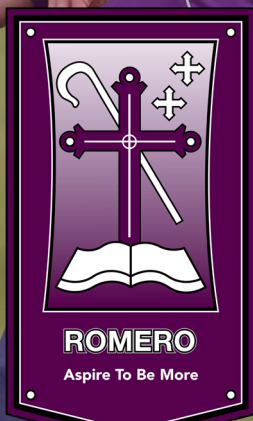

STUDENTS:

- Students are to participate in all activities and will be run in their year groups. The day is to be competitive and in positive supportive spirit for all competitors focusing on best effort. 1st to 4th place ribbons will given in the female and male categories.
- Important to note for the Carnival:
 1. Students are to compete in their own age group and gender.
 2. Students will use the senior atrium toilets and drink taps and sent in pairs.
 3. The event concludes after all races are complete and stay to support other age groups.
 4. Students are to bring hats and water bottles.
 5. Each year level will have their own tent section.

STAFF:

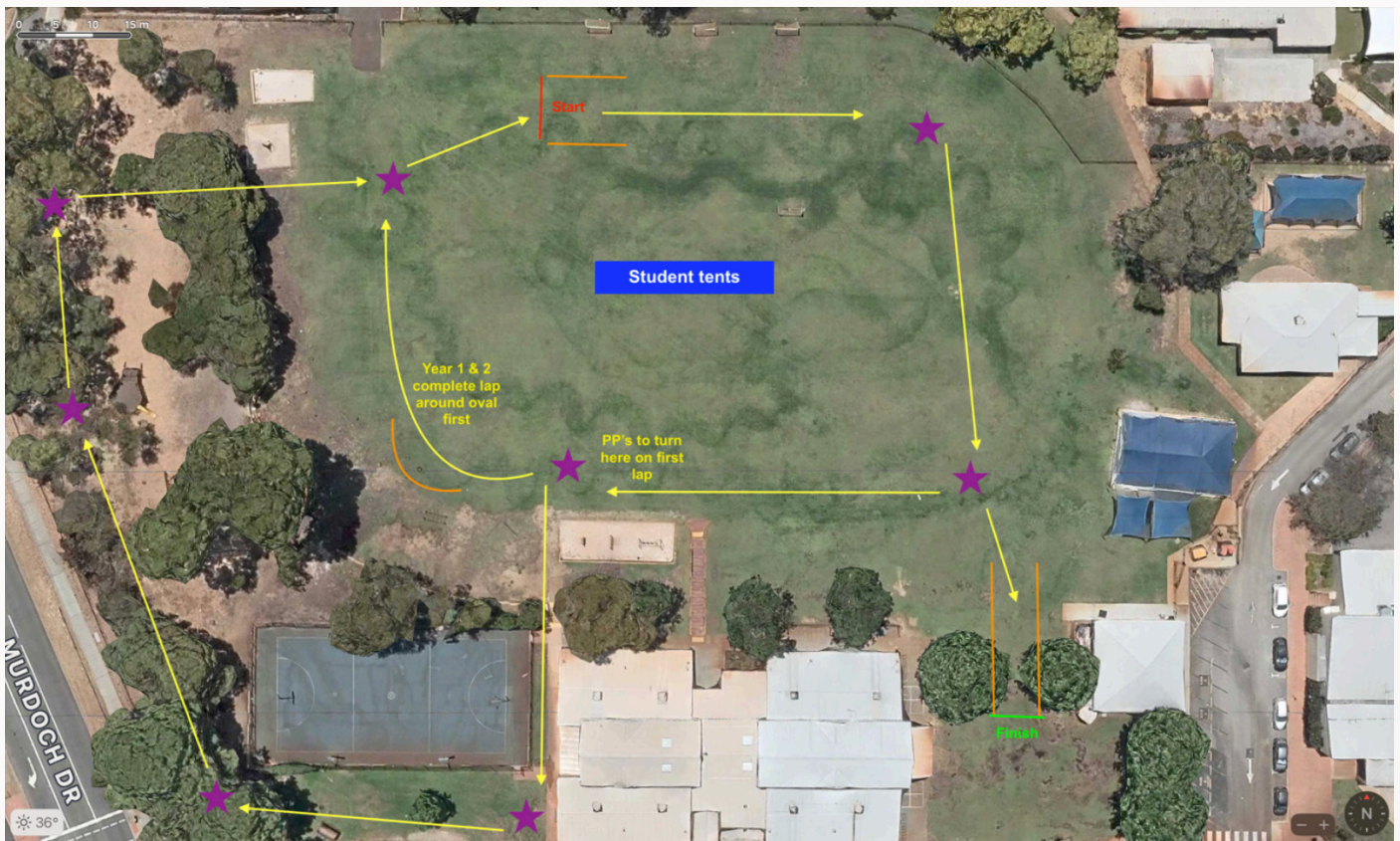
