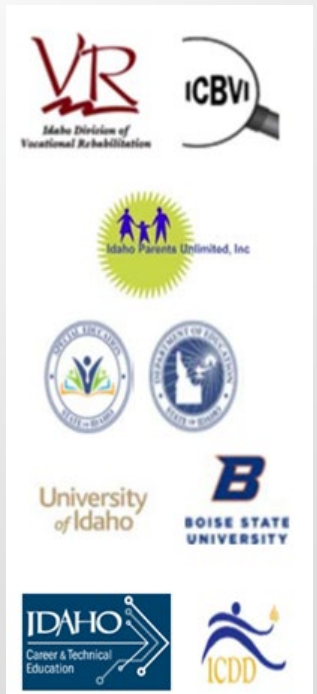

John McNaught, Ed.D.

Dr. McNaught began his career at a residential wilderness school for at-risk youth and youth with emotional disabilities. He also worked in a public high school as a special education teacher and supervised a community-based work-study program for students with disabilities. Dr. McNaught was one of the first individuals in the state of Virginia to implement student-directed IEP meetings, and he worked diligently as an educator to bring the student's voice to the forefront. Dr. McNaught is a founding member and Principal Investigator of the Virginia Department of Education's I'm Determined Project as well as Co-Director for the Virginia Dept. of Ed. Training & Technical Assistance Center at James Madison University.
