Registration & Policies

- The Application Period is January 29 Feb 14, 2020 from 8:00 AM to 2:45 PM in the Guidance Department. No late applications will be accepted.
- Students <u>must</u> consult with their guidance counselor and obtain all appropriate signatures on the front side of this application before applying for LVTI A.D.
- VERY IMPORTANT: (1) A completed Emergency Form (both sides) and a
 Transcript must be attached to this application. (2) Guidance must ensure
 student has a working LPS User Name & Password.
- Credits
- Each course will carry a weight of 1.5 credits.
- This course will appear on your official transcript.
- Failing a credited course could lower your G.P.A.
- Students must attend at least <u>three hours each day for each assigned shop</u> to receive credit for the day and not be considered absent.
- Student attendance will be recorded in each shop.
- Students with more than four (4) absences will be dismissed from the program and receive an F letter grade.
- Any tardy over 30 minutes will be considered an absence.
- Students are not permitted in any other areas of the school except the shop they are assigned, cafeteria, and lavatory rooms.
- Students complete a course by missing no more than two days of the program and completing work to the satisfaction of their shop teacher.
- It is not possible for students to complete their course before the After Dark program concludes.
- Students need to notify the shop teacher when a daily objective is completed.
- Students need to check out with the After Dark Director once their course has been completed.
- Shop uniform/safety equipment must be worn each day. Failure to do so could lower your final grade.
- Students will be issued a final grade upon completion of a course. The course and grade will be posted on the student's transcript. The grade may count towards the student's cumulative average.
- If a student completes and fails a course, the student may retake the course if and when it is offered again at After Dark if space is available.
- The vast majority of program work is done on-site.
- If a student is removed from After Dark for disciplinary or safety reasons, they
 will no longer be welcome to take After Dark courses and will fail current
 course.
- Dismissal and failure is at the discretion of the LVTI After Dark Director.

- An orientation and schedule distribution will occur in a general assembly on the first day – Monday February 24, 2020.
- Dinner will be provided for each student attending LVTI After Dark
- Student may not have more than 6 absences the quarter prior to applying.
- Placement into a program is based on unexcused absences from quarters 1&2 during the 2019-2020 school year. Students with the least unexcused absences will be considered first. Date in which the application was passed in will be used when necessary.
- Withdrawal from the program after the first week will result in an F grade for the course
- Administration or designee retains the right to review all student application on the basis of admission.
